Dear John and Sherry, and friends at Rockville,

Sometimes this is a ploy to get their lands and control over them and move them into another religion. On top of this, at least two teaching points are struggling. One is facing divisions among the believers and in another a leader has fallen in to a sin problem and that work is at a standstill. The new outreach opportunity has also stopped so there are a lot of discouraging things for the believers to deal with. Please pray for them. We certainly seem to be facing opposition on every side, but our responsibility is to walk with God and trust Him for strength, patience and wisdom. The battle is Lord's.

We are hard at work with the meticulous final read of the entire NT. This is the final hurdle before going to press. We cannot believe the number of typos and missing commas and other punctuation marks that have turned up missing. Someone must have messed with it when we weren't looking!!! Pray particularly for Cherri in this as she is not able to do much more than a couple of hours at a time due to the difficulty she has with her eyes.
